When the Barnett Family owned it in the late 1800s, "Beer was 5 cents a glass and often included a sandwich. Dances were held 3-4 times a year. The cost was \$1.50 and included a large buffet.

Rumor has it that the name Tally Ho Inn was chosen "because of the hunting clubs that once gathered here for fox hunts, wine and spirits." Speaking of spirits, what establishment would be complete without a ghost? The Tally Ho is said to be haunted by the ghost of Emily, a young lady who is said to have been killed and buried in the basement. Staff have experienced beer taps opening and knives falling off their racks, and clientele have also seen a ghostly image of a young lady at the top of the stairs.

## Tally Ho Inn Is Shot Full Of Bullet Holes

Joseph Quick, Hartford, reported Monday afternoon that the Washington County Sheriff's Department is investigating a case involving the reckless use of firearms at the Tally Ho Inn, Thompson.

According to Quick, at least six shots were fired at the Tally Ho Inn early Sunday. One of the bullets shattered a piece of the building and Ronald Furno, 23, son of Mr. and Mrs. Al Furno, proprietors, was hit in the abdomen by one of the fragments. Quick described it as a superficial wound. Furno was taken to St. Joseph hospital for treatment however, and released.

The shots were apparently fired from a passing vehicle. The bullets were examined and they were reported to be from a gun of a large size than a .22.

Furno had just come downstairs into the tavern when the shots were fired at about 4:15 a.m.

### Two Arrested

While the officers were at the Tally Ho that morning, there was an incident that resulted in the arrest of Richard Trotter and Donald Burdick of Hartford.

According to District Attorney Robert Kauffman, the two men came there in a car to return beer barrels and taps that were used at a party. They ended up having a scuffle with the officers in the parking lot.

In court on Monday, Trotter pleaded guilty to disorderly conduct and resisting arrest. On the disorderly charge, he was fined \$50 or 15 days in the county jail and on the resisting arrest charge he was fined \$100 or 30 days. He was ordered to pay \$9 court costs plus 1/2 of the costs of replacing an antenna on the squad car and cleaning of the officers clothes.

Burdick pled guilty to the charges also. He was fined \$75 or 20 days on the disorderly charge and \$150 or 50 days on the resisting arrest charge. He was ordered to pay \$9 court costs and the other half of the cost of the antenna and the clothes cleaning bill.

The officers found a gun concealed in the car and the men were charged with having a concealed weapon. The case was adjourned for six months on this charge.
